All notes should be played tenuto, bow on string (*alla corda*). Applies throughout, the few exceptions being indicated by conventional articulation marks. Non legato unless indicated.

On occasions you may find that some double-stops are not entirely practical in the given context.

In such cases it is left upon musician's deliberation to leave out one of the notes, should this help to keep the music smoothly flowing.

No vibrato unless indicated.
